HUGGINS AND HAGGLAND SCHOLARSHIP
FOR CONTINUING EDUCATION

PURPOSE:

To assist individual ONA members with continuing education by providing money in the form of stipends.

TYPE OF PROGRAM:

Continuing education workshops conferences, or nursing education mission such as Northwest Medical Teams only (ONA Convention delegates and NPO Conference are ineligible). Not awarded for formal program of study.

ELIGIBILITY:

Any ONA member, including members of the ONF Board.

STIPEND LIMIT:

1. For traditional classroom continuing education. Each applicant maybe eligible for one stipend of up to \$125 **every (1) year** for registration, travel and/or child care. Priority will be given to first time applicants who haven't received a stipend in two years.
2. For on-line education, the applicant maybe eligible for the cost of registration only of up to \$125.
3. Qualified applications are processed on a first come basis. Ten stipends are available each quarter (July-September; October-December; January-March; and April-June). Non-awarded money per quarter may also be awarded for another quarter in the fiscal year.

APPLICATION:

Application is made by completing the ONF "Huggins/Hagglund Scholarship for Continuing Education Request Form". The "Form" must include a statement about how the offering relates to the applicant's practice. Applications are reviewed quarterly.
